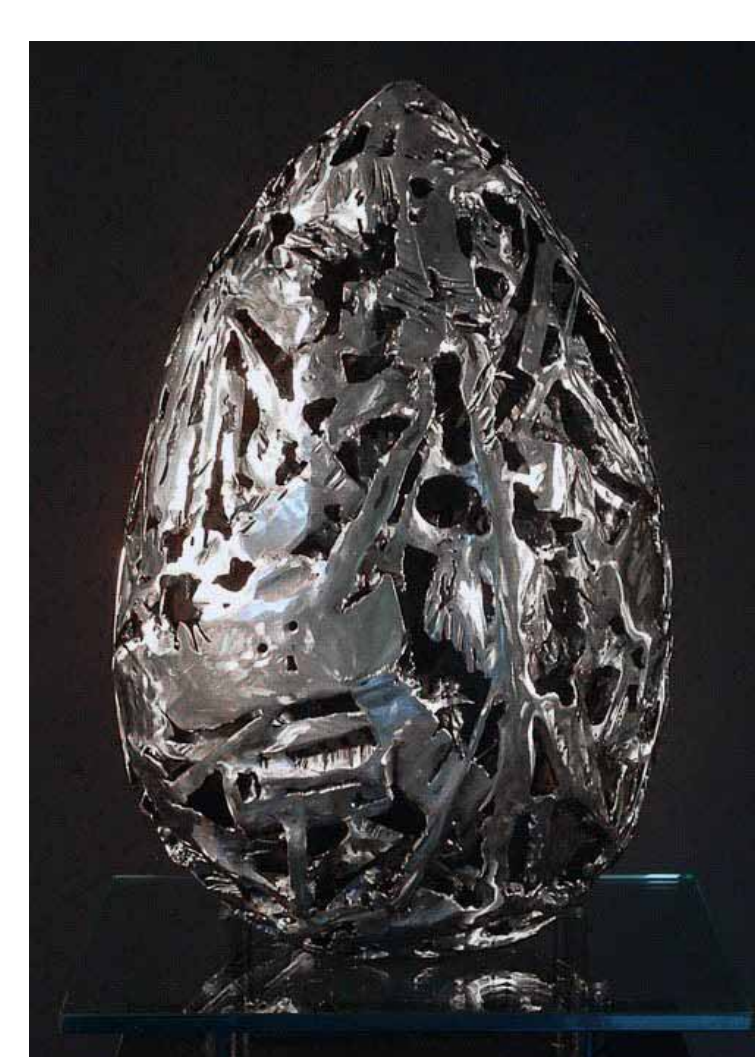

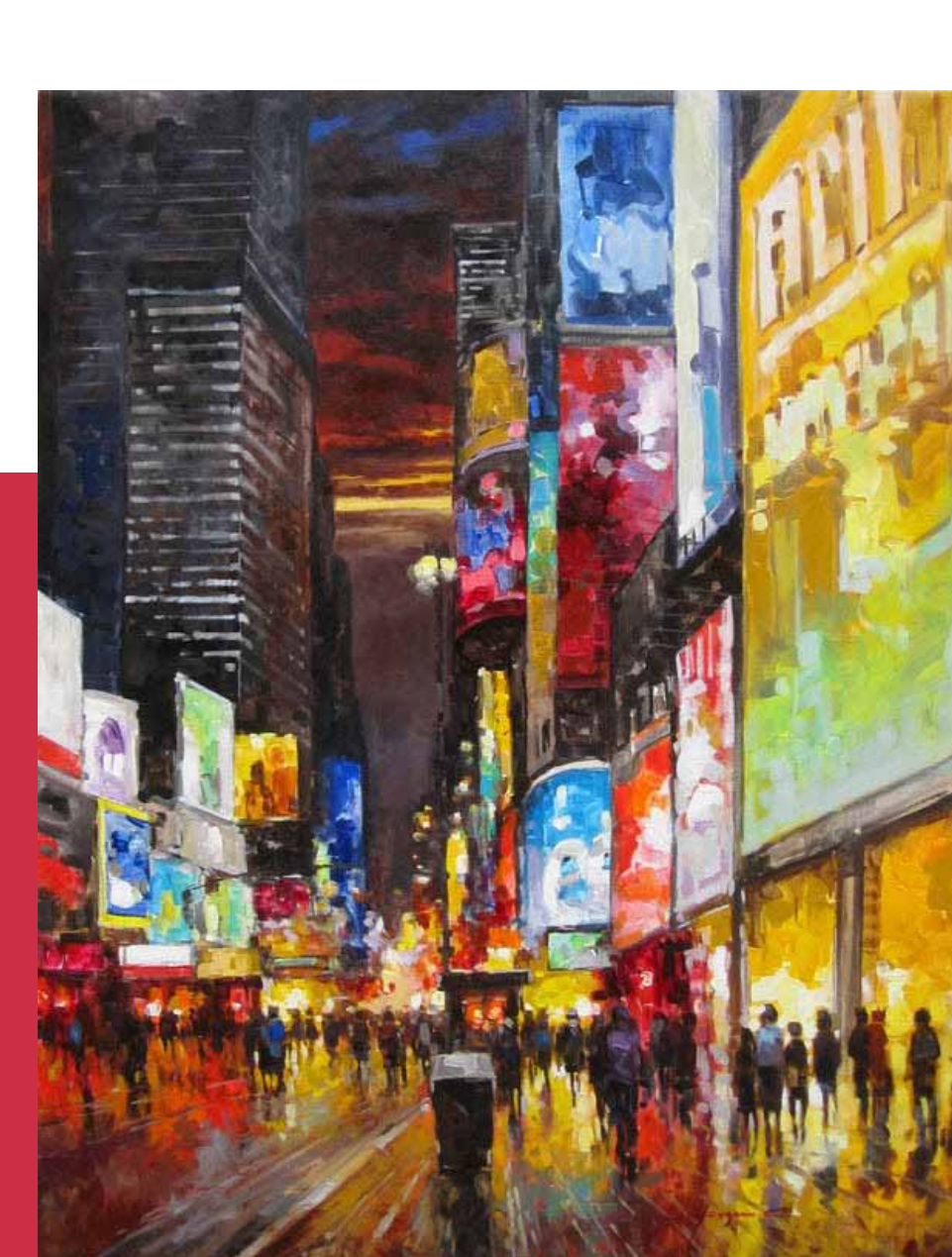


**I**SABELLE SAUVINEAU

A SELF-TAUGHT ARTIST, ISABELLE HAS WORKED OVER FIFTEEN YEARS, FULL TIME, TO PERFECT HER ART. INSPIRED BY MODIGLIANI, TAMARA DE LAMPIKA, ISABELLE HAS DEVELOPED A VERY PERSONAL STYLE AND ORIGINAL SUBJECT MATTER IN WHICH THE FEMALE PERSONA PREDOMINATES. AS AN ARTIST USING VARIED MEDIUMS, HER CHOICE OF PREDILECTION FOR HER MORE SURREAL COMPOSITIONS RESIDES IN OILS, ALLOWING HER FLEXIBILITY IN CREATING HUMAN FORMS IN A MORE CARICATURED STYLE AND LAYERING DEEP VIBRANT COLOURS TO GIVE A RICH ENVELOPING FEELING. WITH THE ACRYLIC MEDIUM, HER PRIMARY SUBJECTS ARE FEMALE FACES, CREATED BY USING VERY BOLD COLOURS AND WITH VERY GESTURAL AND SPONTANEOUS BRUSHWORK, DERIVED FROM THE POP-ART MOVEMENT.

**E**UGENIO CAHALIA

EUGENIO CAHALIA HAS RECENTLY GRADUATED FROM THE FINE ARTS FACULTY AT LIMA'S UNIVERSITY OF PERU. CAHALIA EXECUTES STREET SCENES IN WHICH HIS PERSONAGES APPEAR IN BLURRY AND UNDEFINED FORM. HIS COMPOSITIONS ARE FLOODED WITH STROKES OF BRIGHT PAINT AND REPRESENT THE HIGHLY CHARGED MOVEMENT FOUND IN GREAT URBAN CITYSCAPES. ONLY IN HIS MID-TWENTIES, CAHALIA CAN BOAST OF OVER THIRTY WELL-RECEIVED EXHIBITIONS INCLUDING THOSE PRESENTED AT THE CITY OF TACNA, THE U.S. EMBASSY AND THE BANCO INTERNATIONAL GALLERY. HIS AWARDS INCLUDE FIRST PLACE AT THE URBAN MURALS CONTEST IN TACNA, QUINTO LAZO CONTEST IN TACNA AND A CONTEST ORGANISED BY MICHEL & CO.
