Marie-Josée Roy Creates a 15 Foot tall Sculpture...

Marie-Josée Roy is both a sculptor and a painter. Her mean of communicating her artistic endeavours is metal, and she forges this medium like no other.

Her tridimensional pieces recall the universe of Giacometti by their linear shape. Her figurines are very theatrical and extravagant.

Through her expertise, Marie-Josée Roy is able to render a certain fluidity and warmth to the otherwise rigid medium of metal.



Her two dimensional pieces, engraved on aluminium, also take the viewer by surprise. Roy is able to use the aluminium to her advantage in order to create stunning light contrasts. Her theme is always pertaining to spirituality, the human condition and all of its complexity.

Recently, Marie-Josée Roy participated in Three-Rivers' third edition of 'Les Nuits Polaires'. Being from Three-Rivers herself, for the celebration of the city's 375th anniversary, Marie-Josée Roy donated an elaborate statue standing 15 feet tall.

The metal sculpture represents three strong hands that are open and facing the sky. These hands represent the generations of workers who for the past 375 years, through hard labour, have helped build the city of Three-Rivers, and have made it what it is today.

The 15 foot sculpture was placed in the 'parc portuaire' of the city. An actual flame burns in the middle of the hands representing life, strength, hope, and the future. It was a very generous donation by Marie-Josée Roy, revealing not only her integrity as an artist, but also as a person. Needless to say, Roy is a true artist...

Trépanier travels the world in search of special reclaimed materials or driftwood that will inspire one of her fanciful creations.

Her pieces are not only modern and stylized, they are also useful. For example, her sculptures can often be used as lamps.

Furthermore, the multitude of recycled objects she uses can come from a beach in Gaspé, a garbage can in her neighbourhood, a garage sale, or even an industrial dump. All these inanimate objects speak to her and appear to her transformed and assembled into some dotty character.



Nathalie Trépanier was active in the Montreal artistic community for several years before extending her artistic touch to creating sculptures. From 1998 until 1991, she studied acting at the Conservatoire de Montreal and then later switched to Theatre Design. It was Patrick Amiot, a renowned urban folk artist now living in California, who greatly influenced and encouraged her work as a sculptor.

Her work is daring, outstanding, and unrivalled. She is an all-time original, a must-see for those who seek innovative, newfangled and avant-garde art.
