Produced and presented by the Beauchamp Family, conceived and artistically directed by Ms. Josée-Gabrielle La Bar, the spectacular event entitled 'The Journey of my Soul' held on **May 15th at 49, rue Saint Pierre, Espace B8**, promises to be an artistic experience that will have people talking. Ms. La Bar was inspired by Martin Beaupré's paintings for this 'nouveau-genre' Private View.



Three art forms have been combined for this extravagant event that of painting, dance, and music. Throughout the evening, the public will view a live painting performance by a Quebec artist, Martin Beaupré who is strongly influenced by the Asian culture.
