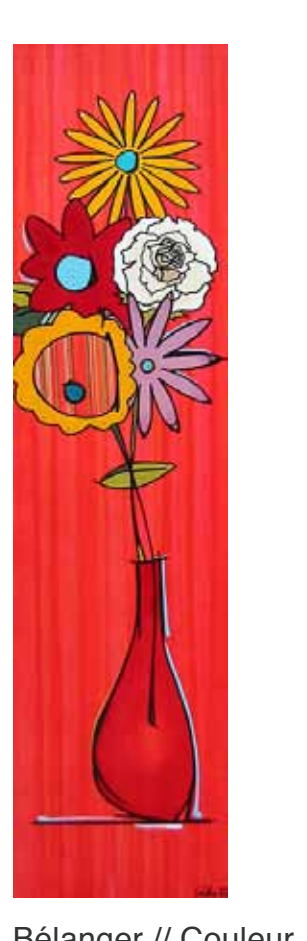

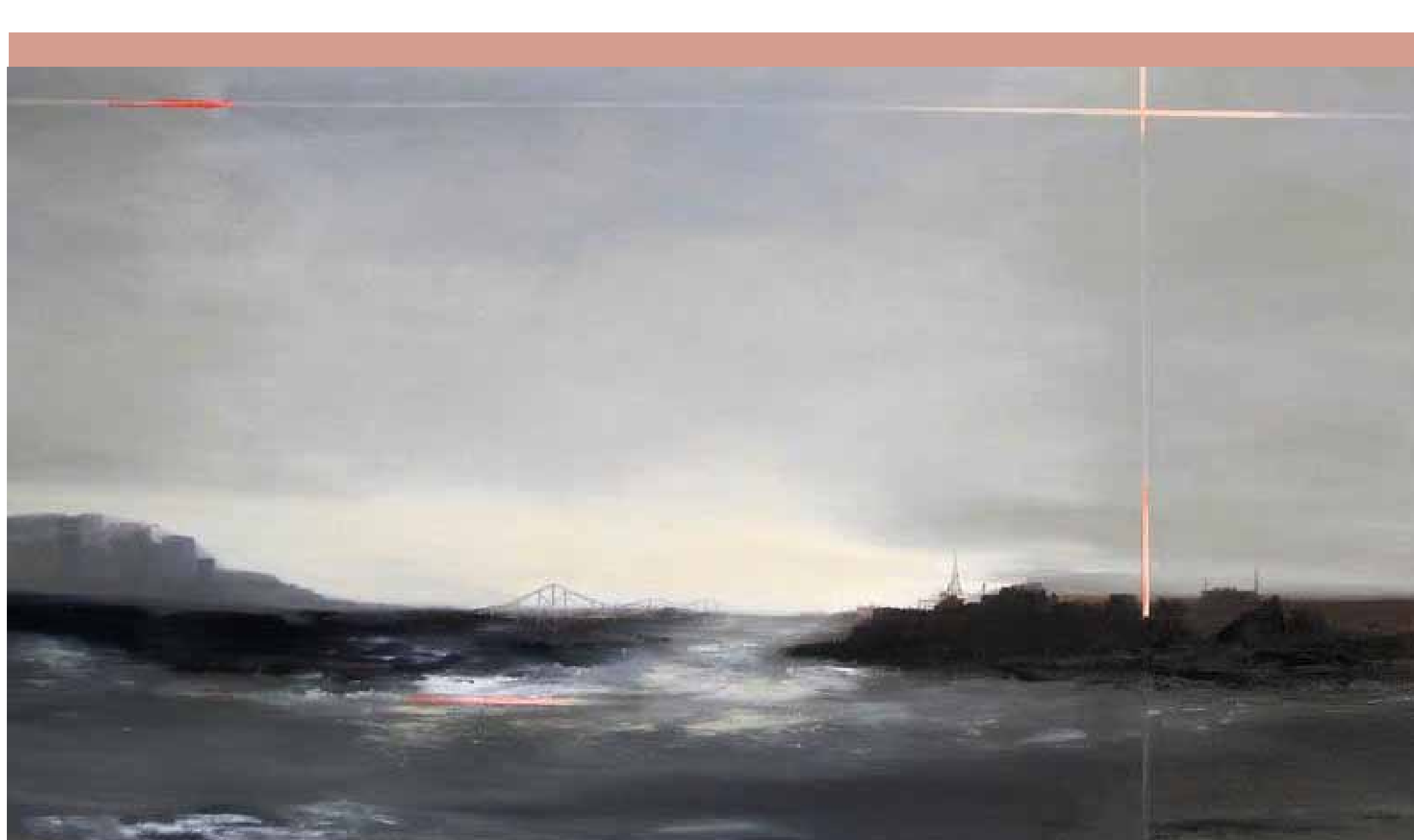

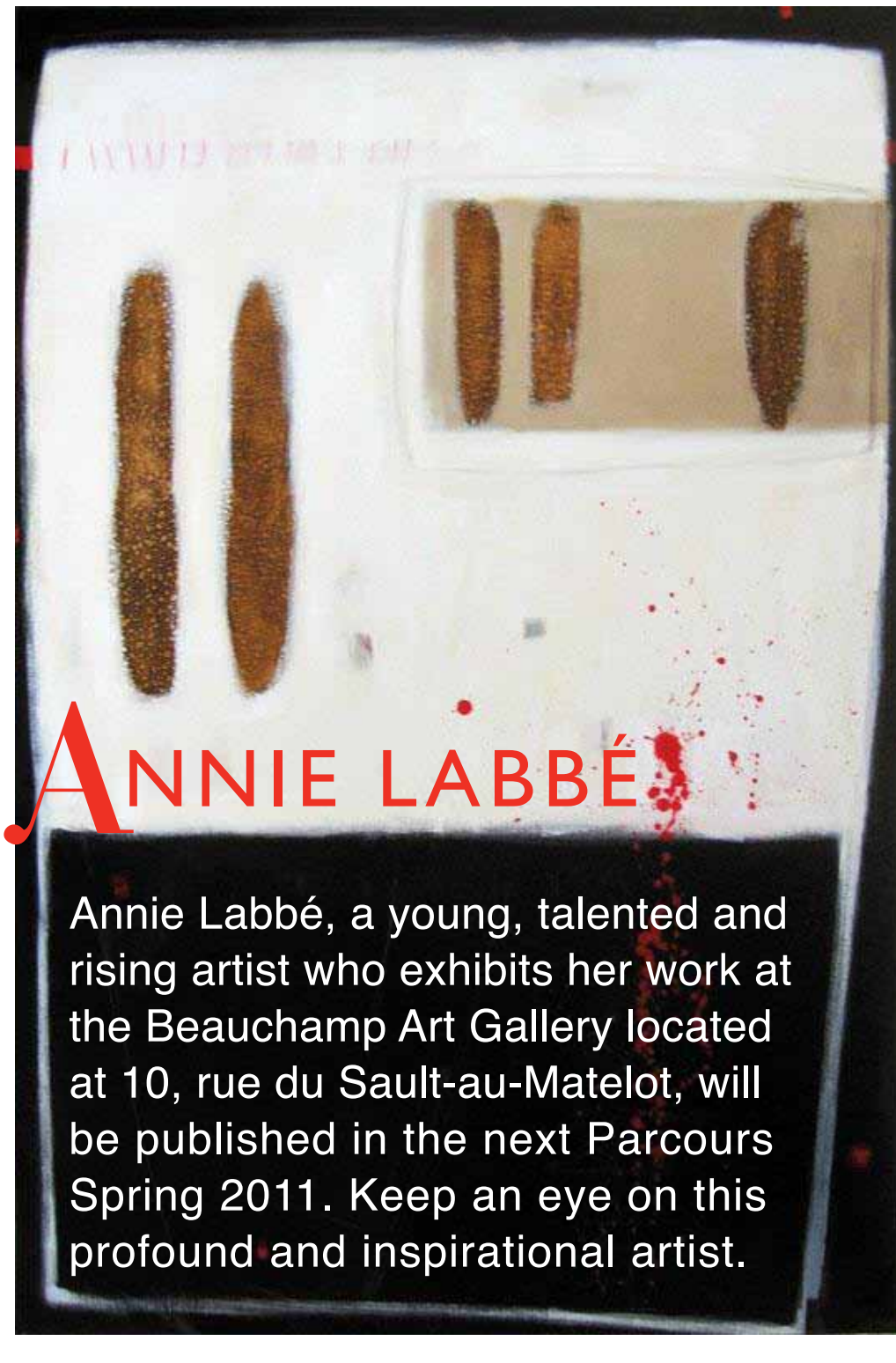


MARIE RIOUX

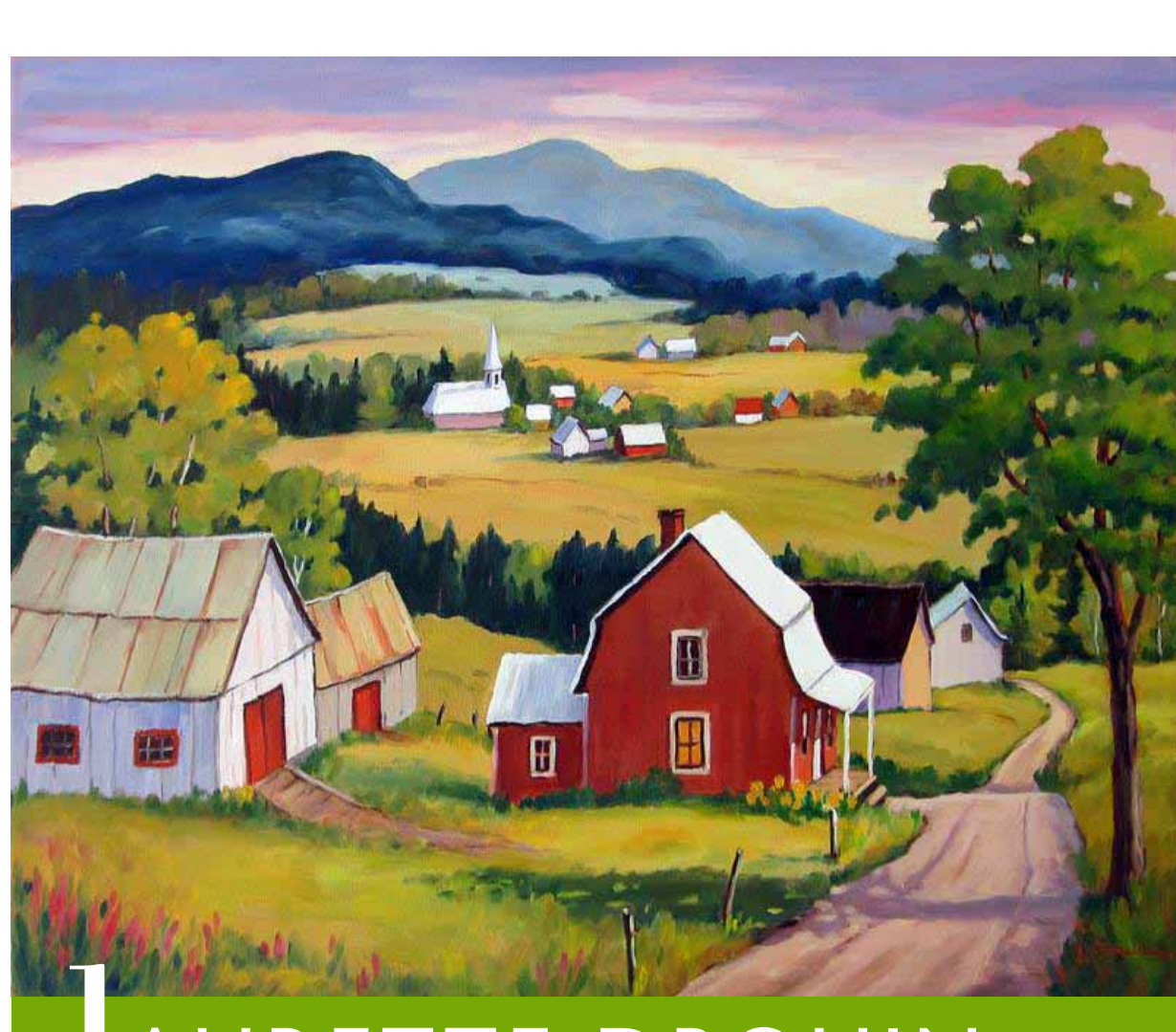
ANNIE LABBÉ

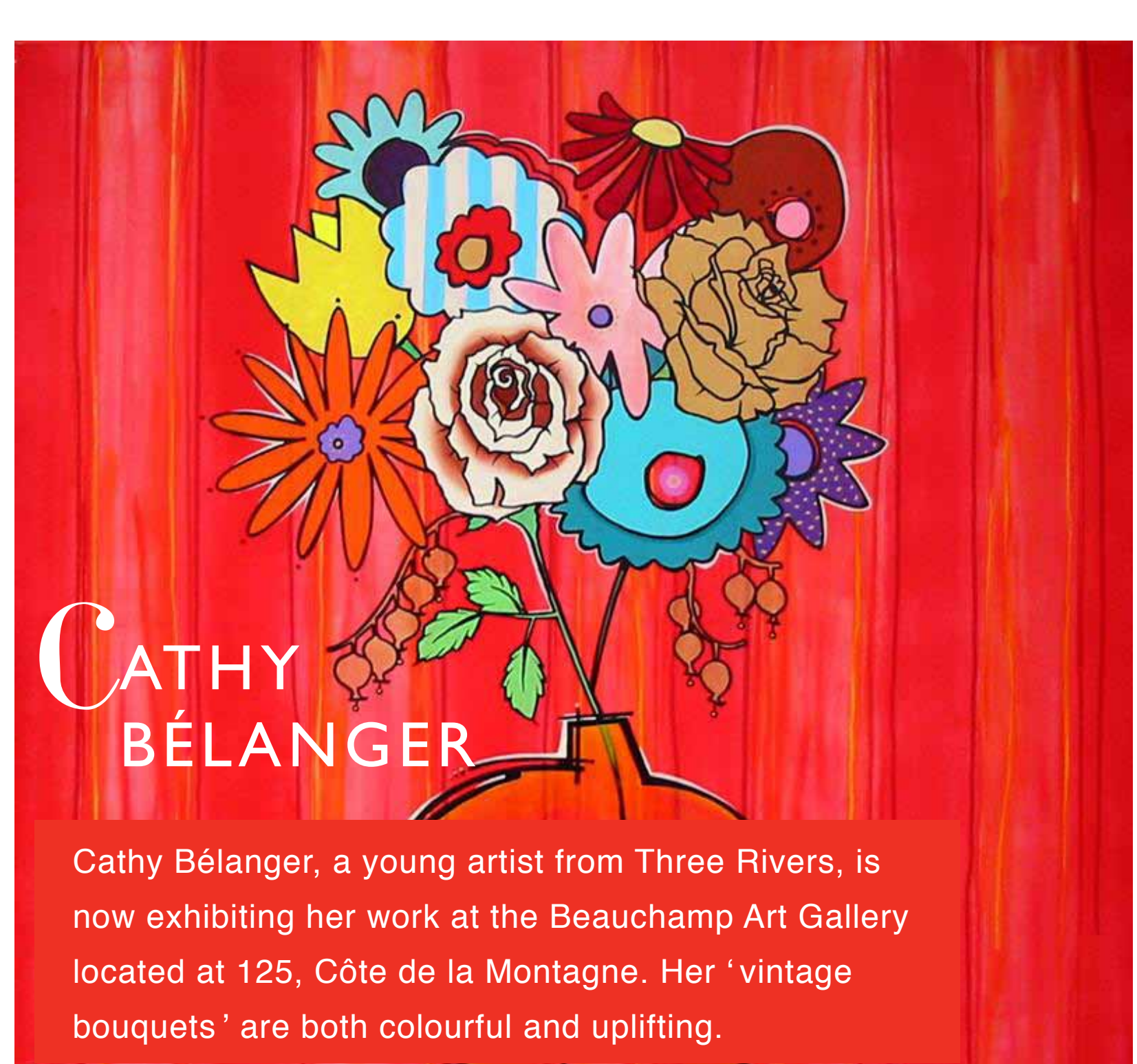
NICK DIGNARD, NEW ARTIST
